

# Train the Trainer

We are looking for 2-3 people interested in taking part in a new **Train the Trainer** course starting in February 2020.

Create Gloucestershire (CG) is offering this opportunity to meet additional need in our team for facilitators, trainers and coaches as we grow over the next 3 years.

You don't need to be a coach, trainer or facilitator to apply: we are more interested in finding people with a passion to bring about individual and creative change in Gloucestershire with an open and optimistic mind set.

## What does the programme involve?

10 days of training delivered between February and July 2020 – dates below. To include:

- 6 days learning first hand as observers on CG's new leadership training programme **catalyst.**
- 4 days of training to develop your coaching, facilitation and training skills and knowledge.
- Approx. 12 hours spread over the 6 months of 1:2:1 coaching to diagnose and develop your individual training and facilitation style delivered via online video calling.

**Create Gloucestershire (CG)** is a diverse network of over 600 individuals and organisations that support the arts and cultural sector in Gloucestershire and introduces new people and places to arts, culture and creativity. The programme will:

- Provide you with a full diagnosis of your individual energies and personal style as a trainer, facilitater and coach.
- Develop your core capabilities in holding teams and groups through creative conversations.
- Bring you into a deeper relationship with CG with potential to take up freelance Catalyst positions with CG in the future
- Develop your training skills, knowledge and coaching capacities, that can be applied to any context

On completion of the **Train the Trainer** course you will be licenced to deliver CG training programmes. This opportunity will only be available to people who have attended the whole programme and have demonstrated minimum learning thresholds.

# Who we are looking for people who:

- Live, work or volunteer in Gloucestershire
- Enjoy unlocking the potential of others
- Have at least 5 years experience of working or volunteering within the community, creative, or public sector.

## Personal skills and qualities:

- Purposeful wants to make a positive contribution to the world
- Open and optimistic sees opportunities rather than burdened by problems
- Can hold a meeting creates vibrant, real and inclusive conversations
- Non-judgemental reflective and a good listener
- Highly skilled at inspiring and enabling people from a variety of cultures, ages and backgrounds to engage
- Good understanding of access, equalities and social inclusion issues
- Digital and media skills
- Willingness to learn

We are particularly keen to hear from people in under-represented groups that are interested in training with us.

CG recognises that there are people whose background and experience is under represented within the creative and cultural sector, both in Gloucestershire and nationally, including women, Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic people, disabled people and people who are deaf and neuro-diverse.

We believe that discrimination or exclusion based on these, or other characteristics or circumstances, such as age, caring or dependency roles, gender or gender equality, partnership status, religious belief, sexual orientation, socio-economic background or other distinctions represents a waste of talent and potential.

#### Fees:

With Arts Council England investment Create Gloucestershire is able to offer this training programme free to 2 or 3 successful applicants who work or volunteer in the community, creative, or public sector.

The full cost of this training programme is £8,000.

# **Access Support Funds:**

Additional financial support is available from an Access Support Fund, which contributes to the additional costs you might have in order to attend the programme. We cannot fund the everyday costs you already pay as a result of your circumstances.
